

1. Prepare to Engage in Worship (Psalm 122:1)

Psalm 122:1I was glad when they said to me, "Let us go to the house of the LORD!"

2. Some Actual Physical/Emotional/Intellectual Participation Required (Psalm 92:1-4; 95:1-7; 96:1-6)

Psalm 92:1It is good to give thanks to the LORD, to sing praises to your name, O Most High;

<sup>2</sup> to declare your steadfast love in the morning, and your faithfulness by night,

3 to the music of the lute and the harp, to the melody of the lyre.

<sup>4</sup> For you, O LORD, have made me glad by your work; at the works of your hands I sing for joy.

Psalm 95:10h come, let us sing to the LORD; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!

<sup>2</sup> Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!

<sup>3</sup> For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.

<sup>4</sup> In his hand are the depths of the earth; the heights of the mountains are his also.

<sup>5</sup>The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land.

<sup>6</sup> Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker!

<sup>7</sup> For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand.

Psalm 96:10h come, let us sing to the LORD; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!

<sup>2</sup> Sing to the LORD, bless his name; tell of his salvation from day to day.

<sup>3</sup> Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!

<sup>4</sup> For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; he is to be feared above all gods.

<sup>5</sup> For all the gods of the peoples are worthless idols, but the LORD made the heavens.

<sup>6</sup> Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and beauty are in his sanctuary.

3. There is a Wrong Way to Worship (Leviticus 10:1-2)

Leviticus 10:1 Now Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, each took his censer and put fire in it and laid incense on it and offered unauthorized fire before the LORD, which he had not commanded

<sup>2</sup> And fire came out from before the LORD and consumed them, and they died before the LORD.
