







Decapolis - The Glorification of All Things Human (Radical Humanism!) (Matthew 5:23-25,

Mark 5:1-13, 18-20

Matt. 5:23 So if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you,

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 ²⁴ leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

²⁵ Come to terms quickly with your accuser while you are going with him to court, lest your accuser hand you over to the judge, and the judge to the guard, and you be put in prison.

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 Mark 5:1They came to the other side of the sea, to the country of the Gerasenes.

² And when Jesus had stepped out of the boat, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit.

³He lived among the tombs. And no one could bind him anymore, not even with a chain,

⁴ for he had often been bound with shackles and chains, but he wrenched the chains apart, and he broke the shackles in pieces. No one had the strength to subdue him.

⁵ Night and day among the tombs and on the mountains he was always crying out and cutting himself with stones.

⁶ And when he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and fell down before him. ⁷And crying out with a loud voice, he said, "What have you to do with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I adjure you by God, do not torment me."

- ⁸ For he was saying to him, "Come out of the man, you unclean spirit!"
- ⁹ And Jesus asked him, "What is your name?" He replied, "My name is Legion, for we are many."

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 ¹⁰ And he begged him earnestly not to send them out of the country. ¹¹ Now a great herd of pigs was feeding there on the hillside,

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 ¹² and they begged him, saying, "Send us to the pigs; let us enter them."

¹³ So he gave them permission. And the unclean spirits came out and entered the pigs; and the herd, numbering about two thousand, rushed down the steep bank into the sea and drowned in the sea.

¹⁸ As he was getting into the boat, the man who had been possessed with demons begged him that he might be with him.

¹⁹ And he did not permit him but said to him, "Go home to your friends and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you."

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 ²⁰ And he went away and began to proclaim in the Decapolis how much Jesus had done for him, and everyone marveled.

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 James 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God," for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts

no one.

¹⁴ But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire.

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 ¹⁵Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.



"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 Disengagement - The Devil Wants Christians to Disassociate and Disconnect from the World (1 Corinthians 5:9-10, 10:27-30)

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 1 Cor. 5:9 I wrote to you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people—

¹⁰ not at all meaning the sexually immoral of this world, or the greedy and swindlers, or idolaters, since then you would need to go out of the world.

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 10:27 If one of the unbelievers invites you to dinner and you are disposed to go, eat whatever is set before you without raising any question on the ground of conscience.

²⁸ But if someone says to you, "This has been offered in sacrifice," then do not eat it, for the sake of the one who informed you, and for the sake of conscience—

²⁹ I do not mean your conscience, but his. For why should my liberty be determined by someone else's conscience?

"Lessons from The Holy Land #4 ³⁰ If I partake with thankfulness, why am I denounced because of that for which I give thanks?
