## Overlooking the Proposed Site of the Tabernacle

### The northern platform

After the Children of Israel entered the Land of Israel, Joshua the son of Nun set up the Tabernacle in Shiloh.

Here at the Tabernacle, the division of land into tribal inheritances was completed, Hannah prayed for a son, and Samuel the Prophet grew up and began to prophesy.

Some researchers believe the Tabernacle stood on the platform flanked by two rock walls at the northern extension of the *tel*. The width of the platform matches the width of the courtyard of the Tabernacle mentioned in the Torah – 50 cubits, and its east-west orientation matches the description of the Tabernacle, whose opening faced east, with the Holy of Holies to the west.

Other sites proposed for the location of the Tabernacle are the summit of the *tel* or an area south of the *tel*.
