

It's Never-Ending Blessings!

1. God will Specifically Speak to Us Through His Word, Mature Christians, **AND Our Obedience** (Matthew 1:20-21)



Matt. 1:20 But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.

²¹ She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."



2. God will Specifically **Protect Us Through His** Intervening AND Our Obedience (Matthew 2:11-12, 13-15)



Matt. 2:11 And going into the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him gifts, gold and frankincense and myrrh.

¹² And being warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed to their own country by another way.

¹³ Now when they had departed, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, "Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there until I tell you, for Herod is about to search for the child, to destroy him."

THE MIRACLES OF CHRISTMAS #5 ¹⁴ And he rose and took the child and his mother by night and departed to Egypt

15 and remained there until the death of Herod. This was to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet, "Out of Egypt I called my son."

3. God will Specifically Lead Us by the Holy Spirit AND Our Willingness (Matthew 2:19-23)



Matt. 2:19 But when Herod died, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt,



²⁰ saying, "Rise, take the child and his mother and go to the land of Israel, for those who sought the child's life are dead."

THE MIRACLES OF CHRISTMAS #5 ²¹ And he rose and took the child and his mother and went to the land of Israel.

²² But when he heard that Archelaus was reigning over Judea in place of his father Herod, he was afraid to go there, and being warned in a dream he withdrew to the district of Galilee.

²³ And he went and lived in a city called Nazareth, so that what was spoken by the prophets might be fulfilled, that he would be called a Nazarene.
