Know Him) (*Mark 16:1-7*)**

Mark 16:1 **When the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices, so that they might go and anoint him.**

² And very early on the first day of the week, when the sun had risen, they went to the tomb.

³ And they were saying to one another, “Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?”

⁴ And looking up, they saw that the stone had been rolled back—it was very large.

⁵ And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed.

⁶ And he said to them, “Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen; he is not here. See the place where they laid him.

⁷ But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going before you to Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.”

John 21:1 **After this Jesus revealed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias, and he revealed himself in this way.**

² Simon Peter, Thomas (called the Twin), Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples were together.

³ Simon Peter said to them, “I am going fishing.” They said to him, “We will go with you.” They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing.

• **Running -- Jesus is Waiting
for Us to Run to Him! (Don't
Be So Proud That You
Refuse) (*John 21:4-11*)**

**John 21:4 Just as day was
breaking, Jesus stood on the
shore; yet the disciples did
not know that it was Jesus.**

**⁵ Jesus said to them,
“Children, do you have
any fish?” They answered
him, “No.”**

Jesus & The Fisherman #6

⁶ He said to them, “Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some.” So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in, because of the quantity of fish.

Jesus & The Fisherman #6

⁷ That disciple whom Jesus loved therefore said to Peter, “It is the Lord!” When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his outer garment, for he was stripped for work, and threw himself into the sea.

⁸ The other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, but about a hundred yards off.

⁹ When they got out on land, they saw a charcoal fire in place, with fish laid out on it, and bread.

**10 Jesus said to them,
“Bring some of the fish
that you have just
caught.”**

¹¹ So Simon Peter went aboard and hauled the net ashore, full of large fish, 153 of them. And although there were so many, the net was not torn.
