



1. Godly Gratitude Never Occurs as a Result of Chance, Fate, or Luck (vv 11-12)



#### Luke 17:11 On the way to Jerusalem he was passing along between Samaria and Galilee.



<sup>12</sup> And as he entered a village, he was met by ten lepers, who stood at a distance



2. Godly Gratitude Begins with Accepting Your Needs (and Helplessness) (v 13)



13 and lifted up their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us."



3. Godly Gratitude = Your Action and Obedience (v 14)



<sup>14</sup> When he saw them he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went they were cleansed.





4. Godly Gratitude will 'Stop You In Your Tracks' to Thank and Praise Jesus! (vv 15-16a)



15 Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice;

<sup>16a</sup> and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, giving him thanks.

5. Bonus: God Often Blesses Those Most Whom He **Knows Will** Appreciate His Blessings Most (vv 16b-19)



<sup>16b</sup>Now he was a Samaritan.

<sup>17</sup>Then Jesus answered, "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine?





<sup>18</sup> Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?"



<sup>19</sup> And he said to him, "Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well."
