

AFTER EASTER #5:

Paul's Salvation...and The Most Important Thing!

Text: Acts

1. Saul Before Salvation: Prestige & Pledged (22:1-3; 26:4; 7:54-58; 8:1; 22:4-5)

^{22:1} Brothers and fathers, hear the defense that I now make before you."

² And when they heard that he was addressing them in the Hebrew language, they became even more quiet. And he said:

³ "I am a Jew, born in Tarsus in Cilicia, but brought up in this city, educated at the feet of Gamaliel according to the strict manner of the law of our fathers, being zealous for God as all of you are this day.

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! 26:4 "My manner of life from my youth, spent from the beginning among my own nation and in Jerusalem, is known by all the Jews.

7:54 Now when they heard these things they were enraged, and they ground their teeth at him.

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! 55 But he, full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God.

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! ⁵⁶ And he said, "Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."

⁵⁷ But they cried out with a loud voice and stopped their ears and rushed together at him.

58 Then they cast him out of the city and stoned him. And the witnesses laid down their garments at the feet of a young man named Saul.

8:1 And Saul approved of his execution.

And there arose on that day a great persecution against the church in Jerusalem, and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles.

22:4 I persecuted this Way to the death, binding and delivering to prison both men and women,

⁵ as the high priest and the whole council of elders can bear me witness. From them I received letters to the brothers, and I journeyed toward Damascus to take those also who were there and bring them in bonds to Jerusalem to be punished.

2. Saul During Salvation: Conviction & Confirmation (26:12-15; 9:6-18)

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! 26:12 'In this connection I journeyed to Damascus with the authority and commission of the chief priests.

¹³ At midday, 0 king, I saw on the way a light from heaven, brighter than the sun, that shone around me and those who journeyed with me.

¹⁴ And when we had all fallen to the ground, I heard a voice saying to me in the Hebrew language, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads.'

¹⁵ And I said, 'Who are you, Lord?' And the Lord said, 'I am Jesus whom you are persecuting.

9:6 But rise and enter the city, and you will be told what you are to do."

⁷The men who were traveling with him stood speechless, hearing the voice but seeing no one.

⁸ Saul rose from the ground, and although his eyes were opened, he saw nothing. So they led him by the hand and brought him into Damascus.

⁹ And for three days he was without sight, and neither ate nor drank.

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! ¹⁰ Now there was a disciple at Damascus named Ananias. The Lord said to him in a vision, "Ananias." And he said, "Here I am, Lord."

11 And the Lord said to him, "Rise and go to the street called Straight, and at the house of Judas look for a man of Tarsus named Saul, for behold, he is praying,

12 and he has seen in a vision a man named Ananias come in and lay his hands on him so that he might regain his sight."

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! ¹³ But Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much evil he has done to your saints at Jerusalem.

14 And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on your name."

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! ¹⁵ But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen instrument of mine to carry my name before the Gentiles and kings and the children of Israel.

¹⁶ For I will show him how much he must suffer for the sake of my name."

¹⁷So Ananias departed and entered the house. And laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."

¹⁸ And immediately something like scales fell from his eyes, and he regained his sight. Then he rose and was baptized;

3. Paul After Salvation: Immediate Obedience & Commitment Forever! (9:18-29)

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! 19 and taking food, he was strengthened. For some days he was with the

disciples at Damascus.

²⁰ And immediately he proclaimed Jesus in the synagogues, saying, "He is the Son of God."

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! ²¹ And all who heard him were amazed and said, "Is not this the man who made havoc in Jerusalem of those who called upon this name? And has he not come here for this purpose, to bring them bound before the chief priests?"

²² But Saul increased all the more in strength, and confounded the Jews who lived in Damascus by proving that Jesus was the Christ.

- ²³ When many days had passed, the Jews plotted to kill him,
- ²⁴ but their plot became known to Saul. They were watching the gates day and night in order to kill him,

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! ²⁵ but his disciples took him by night and let him down through an opening in the wall, lowering him in a basket.

²⁶ And when he had come to Jerusalem, he attempted to join the disciples. And they were all afraid of him, for they did not believe that he was a disciple.

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! ²⁷ But Barnabas took him and brought him to the apostles and declared to them how on the road he had seen the Lord, who spoke to him, and how at Damascus he had preached boldly in the name of Jesus.

28 So he went in and out among them at Jerusalem, preaching boldly in the name of the Lord.

²⁹ And he spoke and disputed against the Hellenists. But they were seeking to kill him.

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! The Most Important Thing: The Gospel is FOR EVERYONE! (Not Just the 'Predestined' Few 22:21; 26:16-20)

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! 22:21 And he said to me, 'Go, for I will send you far away to the Gentiles."


AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! ^{26:16} But rise and stand upon your feet, for I have appeared to you for this purpose, to appoint you as a servant and witness to the things in which you have seen me and to those in which I will appear to you,

17 delivering you from your people and from the Gentiles—to whom I am sending you

¹⁸ to open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.'

19 6 Therefore, O King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision,

AFTER EASTER #5: Paul's Salvation... and The Most Important Thing! ²⁰ but declared first to those in Damascus, then in Jerusalem and throughout all the region of Judea, and also to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, performing deeds in keeping with their repentance.
