3. They are Who They Run

a Backslidden Christian.)  
(1:10-16)

1:10 My son, if sinners  
entice you, do not  
consent.

11 If they say, "Come with us, let us lie in wait for blood; let us ambush the innocent without reason;

<sup>12</sup> like Sheol let us  
swallow them alive, and  
whole, like those who go  
down to the pit;

4. Allow Them to Face  
Consequences & Criticism  
(22:15; 20:11; 17:10)

# **SUCCESS #7: Raising Accomplished - *Not Arrogant* - Children**

22:15 Folly is bound up in the heart of a child, but the rod of discipline drives it far from him.

# **SUCCESS #7: Raising Accomplished - *Not Arrogant* - Children**

20:11 Even a child makes himself known by his acts, by whether his conduct is pure and upright.

# **SUCCESS #7: Raising Accomplished - *Not Arrogant* - Children**

17:10 A rebuke goes deeper into a man of understanding than a hundred blows into a fool.

# **SUCCESS #7: Raising Accomplished - *Not Arrogant* - Children**

5. Teach Them to Be Quick  
to Listen - Slow to Speak  
(16:23: 17:7, 27; 18:2)

# **SUCCESS #7: Raising Accomplished - *Not Arrogant* - Children**

16:23 The heart of the wise  
makes his speech judicious  
and adds persuasiveness to  
his lips.

# **SUCCESS #7: Raising Accomplished - *Not Arrogant* - Children**

17:7 Fine speech is not  
becoming to a fool;  
still less is false speech to  
a prince.



# **SUCCESS #7: Raising Accomplished - *Not Arrogant* - Children**

27 Whoever restrains his words has knowledge, and he who has a cool spirit is a man of understanding.

18:2 A fool takes no pleasure in understanding, but only in expressing his opinion.


6. Biblical Wisdom (AKA

ruin.

19:11 Good sense makes

an offense.
