

1. Crossroads' Leaders Grabbing the Vision! (Proverbs 9:9)

Prov. 9:9 Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be still wiser; teach a righteous man, and he will increase in learning.

2. First Impressions are Everything (Proverbs 15:13), Followed by Construction/ Renovation (Proverbs 24:3)

Prov. 15:13 A glad heart makes a cheerful face, but by sorrow of heart the spirit is crushed.

Prov. 24:3 By wisdom a house is built, and by understanding it is established;

3. Let's Be a Church That Aims for Excellence in Everything! (Daniel 5:12; 6:3)

Daniel 5:12 because an excellent spirit, knowledge, and understanding to interpret dreams, explain riddles, and solve problems were found in this Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar. Now let Daniel be called, and he will show the interpretation."

Daniel 6:3 Then this Daniel became distinguished above all the other high officials and satraps, because an excellent spirit was in him. And the king planned to set him over the whole kingdom.

4. Small Groups and Ministries: Make Room for Growth (Hebrews 10:24-25)

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,

²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

5. Retired Seniors Lead as Volunteers (Psalm 71:18; 92:14)

Psalm 71:18 So even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim your might to another generation, your power to all those to come.

92:14 They still bear fruit in old age; they are ever full of sap and green,

6. Watch Out for Satan's Attacks on Unity (Making Disagreements Personal; Condemning Each Other; Talking Negatively About Each Other) (Galatians 5:13-15)

Gal. 5:13 For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.
