*(James 5:7-11)***

James 5:7 Be patient, therefore, brothers, until the coming of the Lord. See how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, being patient about it, until it receives the early and the late rains.

**3. Christians Must Call on
the Church for Strength and
Prayer During Sickiness
*(James 5:14-15)***

James 5:14 Is anyone among you sick?
Let him call for the elders of the
church, and let them pray over
him, anointing him with oil in the
name of the Lord.

¹⁵ And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

4. Christians Should Confess
(and Be Accountable) to
Fellow Believers
(James 5:16)
