Mark 15:21 And they compelled a passerby, Simon of Cyrene, who was coming in from the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to carry his cross.

**Romans 16:13 Greet Rufus,
chosen in the Lord; also
his mother, who has been
a mother to me as well.**

Mark 15:39 And when the centurion, who stood facing him, saw that in this way he breathed his last, he said, “Truly this man was the Son of God!”

**3. Jesus Had(!) to be
Crucified for Our Sins
(*Mark 15:22-38*)**

Mark 15:22 And they brought him to the place called Golgotha (which means Place of a Skull).

²³ And they offered him wine mixed with myrrh, but he did not take it.

**²⁴ And they crucified him
and divided his garments among
them, casting lots for them, to
decide what each should take.**

**²⁵ And it was the third hour when
they crucified him.**

²⁶ And the inscription of the charge against him read, “The King of the Jews.”

**27 And with him they
crucified two robbers,
one on his right and one
on his left.**

29 And those who passed by derided him, wagging their heads and saying, “Aha! You who would destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days,

³⁰ save yourself, and come down from the cross!”

³¹ So also the chief priests with the scribes mocked him to one another, saying, “He saved others; he cannot save himself.

³² Let the Christ, the King of Israel, come down now from the cross that we may see and believe.” Those who were crucified with him also reviled him.

33 And when the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour.

**34 And at the ninth hour
Jesus cried with a loud
voice, “Eloi, Eloi, lema
sabachthani?” which
means, “My God, my God,
why have you forsaken me?”**

bystanders hearing it
said, “Behold, he is
calling Elijah.”**

³⁶ And someone ran and filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on a reed and gave it to him to drink, saying, “Wait, let us see whether Elijah will come to take him down.”

³⁸ And the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom.

**4. Jesus Was 100% Dead
and Buried = No Hope
(*John 19:28-30, 33-37,
38-42*)**

John 19:28 After this, Jesus, knowing that all was now finished, said (to fulfill the Scripture), “I thirst.”

JESUS: HIS FINAL 24 HOURS (Final)

29 A jar full of sour wine stood there, so they put a sponge full of the sour wine on a hyssop branch and held it to his mouth.

³⁰ When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, “It is finished,” and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

33 But when they came to Jesus and saw that he was already dead, they did not break his legs.

**³⁴ But one of the soldiers
pierced his side with a
spear, and at once there
came out blood and water.**

35 He who saw it has borne witness—his testimony is true, and he knows that he is telling the truth—that you also may believe.

³⁶ For these things took place that the Scripture might be fulfilled: “Not one of his bones will be broken.”

**³⁷ And again another
Scripture says, “They
will look on him whom
they have pierced.”**

³⁸ After these things Joseph of Arimathea, who was a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, asked Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus, and Pilate gave him permission. So he came and took away his body.

³⁹ Nicodemus also, who earlier had come to Jesus by night, came bringing a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about seventy-five pounds in weight.

⁴⁰ So they took the body of Jesus and bound it in linen cloths with the spices, as is the burial custom of the Jews.

⁴¹ Now in the place where he was crucified there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb in which no one had yet been laid.

⁴² So because of the Jewish day of Preparation, since the tomb was close at hand, they laid Jesus there.
